From the shepherd's pen:

After their deliverance from Egyptian bondage, an estimated one million Hebrews fled Egypt into the Wilderness of Sin. They were unable to provide for themselves basic necessities, even food. They despaired and grumbled about their plight (Exodus 16:1-3). But God said, "Behold I will rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a day's portion everyday, that I may test them, whether or not they walk in my instruction." (vs. 4) God no longer sends physical "manna" to us daily, but He does provide spiritual food for us constantly. It is called His Word! We, too, wander in a "wilderness of sin." and need daily spiritual nourishment. Just as He required the Hebrews to gather manna everyday, we, too, should gather spiritual manna daily. Only one or two "servings" of His Word will not spiritually sustain us anymore than one or two meals a week would physically be sufficient! Are you getting your daily spiritual nourishment?

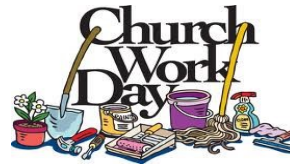
