From the shepherd's pen:

Today is Resurrection Sunday!

"But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus..." Luke 24:1-3

Did you know that this Christian celebration of Jesus' resurrection is also Passover? This is originally the Jewish celebration of the Exodus when the Israelites were led out of Egypt. The angel of death passed over those who were safe in their homes with the blood of the lamb on the doorpost and, later in the night, allowed them all to leave for freedom. The Israelites headed east toward a sunrise into freedom because of a lamb's blood.

Jesus was arrested, crucified, and buried during the Passover. The Lamb shed His own blood for the doorpost. That Sunday morning, the sun rose and shined into an empty tomb.

"I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture." (John 10:9)

We live during the "in-between" of the empty tomb of a Sunday sunrise and Jesus' return. Celebrating His Resurrection is more than a yearly feast for Christians; it is also a weekly reminder that the Lamb shed His blood on His own doorpost so that we might have an Exodus at sunrise with eternal freedom in Heaven.


