The shepherd's pen:

Throughout the Bible we read of a God who requires
obedience, faith, and undivided loyalty to Him. In
obedience, we demonstrate our faith. In faith, we
demonstrate obedience. But it requires BOTH, faith
and obedience to show loyalty.

Throughout the Bible we read of people who failed to
obey, lost faith for a moment, and betrayed God
ignoring His warnings and promises. Over and over,
individuals and a whole nation show what disobe-
dience looks like, how many times a lost faith can hurt
them, and how punishment can feel.

and bring you to Zion...” declares The Lord.
(Jeremiah 3:14-15)

in our transgressions, made us alive together with
Christ, by grace you have been saved...”(Ephesians
2:4-5)
